



The Society of Physics Students chapter at Bowling Green State University is going kart racing on April 14, 2007 in the second annual Grand Prix of BGSU, and is seeking your involvement as a sponsor of our team, Quantum Racing. The Physics and Astronomy Department at Bowling Green State University views this as a real life application of the science of physics. It will teach skills in a setting that is comparable to real life research in the form of goal setting, team building, data collection and management, and budgeting and fundraising. As a sponsor you will help in our pursuit of victory in this event, while showing your support of an education at Bowling Green State University and advertising to customers in the BGSU community.

The Grand Prix, now in its second year, was modeled after the successful Purdue Grand Prix which in 2006 celebrated fifty years of kart races. The Grand Prix of BGSU has been designed to teach the students involved many interdisciplinary skills through the excitement and challenge of motor sports. This year the race will be held on April 14, 2006 on the BGSU campus. All teams will be running a spec tire package and engine to encourage competition and will also be using Ethanol E85 (85% ethanol) fuel. The goal is to bring attention to a renewable fuel source that is gaining public support through efforts of the large American automotive companies. Attention to safety has been included in the specifications for the kart and in the racing rules.

We are seeking a minimum sponsorship of \$500.00 to secure the title sponsorship of Quantum Racing. We estimate that total expenses will be between \$2-3,000.00. This money will go towards the upkeep and maintenance of our team as well as educational opportunities. Potential sponsors are lining up now, and we are seeking to put our sponsorship package together by mid to late February, 2007. Your sponsorship of our race team will not only get you visible recognition on our kart, uniforms, and at the track, but arrangements can be made for public display of the kart at your business site or special event between our testing and race dates. Consideration of the graphics package will be based on the amount and order in which our sponsorship is received, with all attempts being made to accommodate your company's logo and colors.
