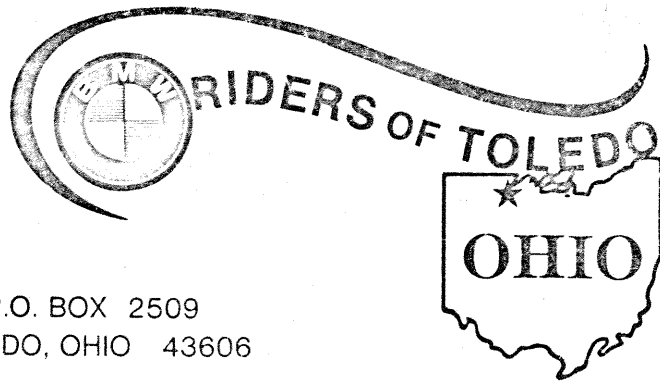

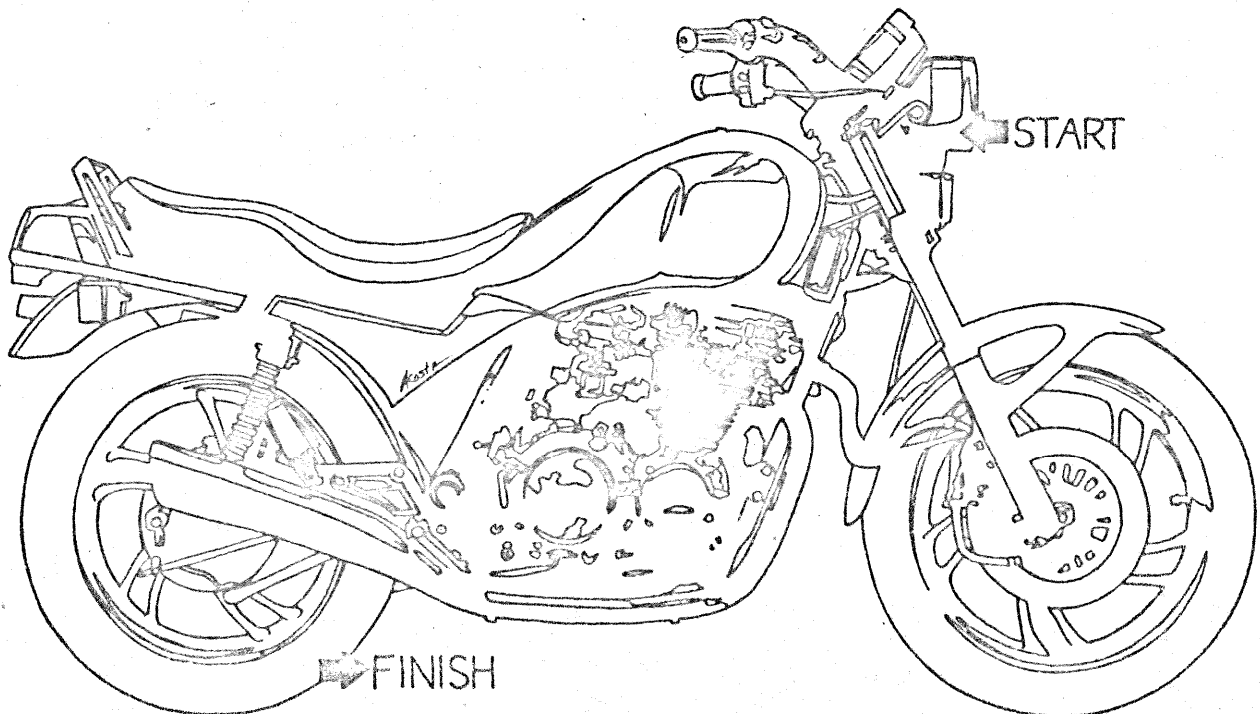
MILEAGE CONTEST
