

By the way, the July meeting will be held at the regular place at 8:00 , the evening of the 14th. The subject of the AMA renewal was brought up and a \$100.00 donation to this cause was voted upon and passed. There was a discussion of the State Rally and it was decided that we will participate only. The meeting was adjourned at 9:30.
