The BMW MOA 21st National Rally is coming up July 22 - 25 in Oshkosh Wisconsin.

The Merzke's have extended an open invitation to club members and their riding companions planning to ride through Michigan

on their way to the rally. Lois and Jim Merzke have a cottage at Black Lake in Michigan about 300mi. north of Toledo. Jim's directions indicate that it is another 350mi to the rally. Sounds like a halfway point to me. The directions are as follows:

Take U.S.23 north to I-75 (south of Flint). Follow I-75 on north to exit 202 at Alger or S.R33. Take 33 north through Rose City, the Huron Nat. Forest, Mio, Fairview, Comins Atlanta, and finally to Onaway (these are all small towns and easy to pass through).

At Onaway there is a blinking stop light, 33 makes a left turn at this light. Follow 33 for @ 1.5mi. or till you find County Road F05, which will be on the right. Take F05 about 4mi. to an intersection with a large sign for the U.A.W. Black Lake Education Center, turn left here, this is Black River Rd. It starts out as South and becomes North Black River Road.

The house numbers on the south part run from high to low, then run from low to high on the north part. Our address is 372 North Black River Rd. and our name and number is on the mail box. Our house number is also on the garage and cottage. The cottage is light green trimmed in whitewith white shutters, the garage is the same color.

An alternate route for those who prefer to hammer the super slab would be: Follow I-75 on north

past exit 202 way north on past Grayling and Gaylord to exit 310 for state routs 33 and 66and go east past Afton toward Onaway. Of course then C.R. F05 will be on the left side.
