Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were read by the Secretary. There were no additions or changes. Dale made the motion to accept the minutes as read and Jim Merzke seconded. The motion passed unopposed.

Financial Report: Leo was absent so we have no financial report for the month of November and no report on the status of the bank account move to a new location.

Officers Reports:

President: Nothing to report.

Vice-President: Absent.

Secretary: I sent a letter to Norm de Groot club coordinator of the BMW MOA requesting the bronze medallion offered each year to the member clubs. Committee Chair Reports:

Rally Chair: The rally chair arrived late and the secretary attempted to pass along the info. which Jim had related and this stimulated much discussion. The Rally Chair clarified much of the confusion when he arrived. Jim told us of his conversations with Joann Trumann, the owner of the Mid-Ohio Race course, they have told Jim that we can hve a significant discount on tickets wether we camp there or not. They indicated that normally a weekend of races with camping is \$40.00 they are saying they will probably charge us \$25.00. In addition they will set aside an area near the showers in the quiet camping area. They are very interested in working with us. He also says he has been in touch with the Mansfield Convention and Visitors Bureau and they are sending him a complete list of campgrounds which they reccommend. The C&V Bureau will also attempt to get us a discount for breakfast at a local restaurant.

Much discussion was had about the various issues and possibilities.

Dale made the motion that the Rally committee be empowered to make the commitments for the club and that it must be a unanimous decision by all members of the committee. Seconded by Don Smith. The motion passed unanimously.

Old Business: Open for further nominations for club officers. The secretary nominated Rob Piechocki for the position of Road Captain, I had talked to Rob and he indicated that he would stand for the office. There were no other nominations at this time.

January banquet. Don Smith checked out the Oak Harbor hotel and they are closed during January. Owen wrote the secretary a note about The Bay Shore Supper Club which let me know that Sonny will only seat us in the front dining room with other patrons and we have to order off the general menu.

The secretary looked into the Town & Country on S.R.25 at the corner of E. South Boundry in Perrysburg.
