Dale brought up the possibility of name tags for club members.


There was also a discussion about cards like a club card that you could pass out. More info next meeting.



Power of the Heart



BART'S THOUGHTS Nov. 2002

Did you ever know someone that had a name for their motorcycle? You know like a person's name, or well even something such as old yeller or the red hornet. They have an attachment to that machine that may confound one who does not relate to his machine in the same way. Of course once the boundary has been crossed, name given or not, the next step would be affording emotions or even intelligence to it. Talking to it could follow. Talking friendly, talking stemly, which is a common to the common template swearing also. I guess. It's plastic. paint, and metal mostly, that thing parked in the garage. Where am I going with this? No farther than this. Because I don't want to offend anyone in our Club? No. no farther since it isn't going anywhere.

Where else can you ride 15 miles in NW Ohio and do more than 60 bends and curves and not follow a river? NO! Not in a city. With only four stop signs it is a gentle ride posted at 45 mph passing 6 manual and cemeteries, farm houses close in on both sides of the road and going through 3 or 4 very small towns.
