**Message from our Road Captain**

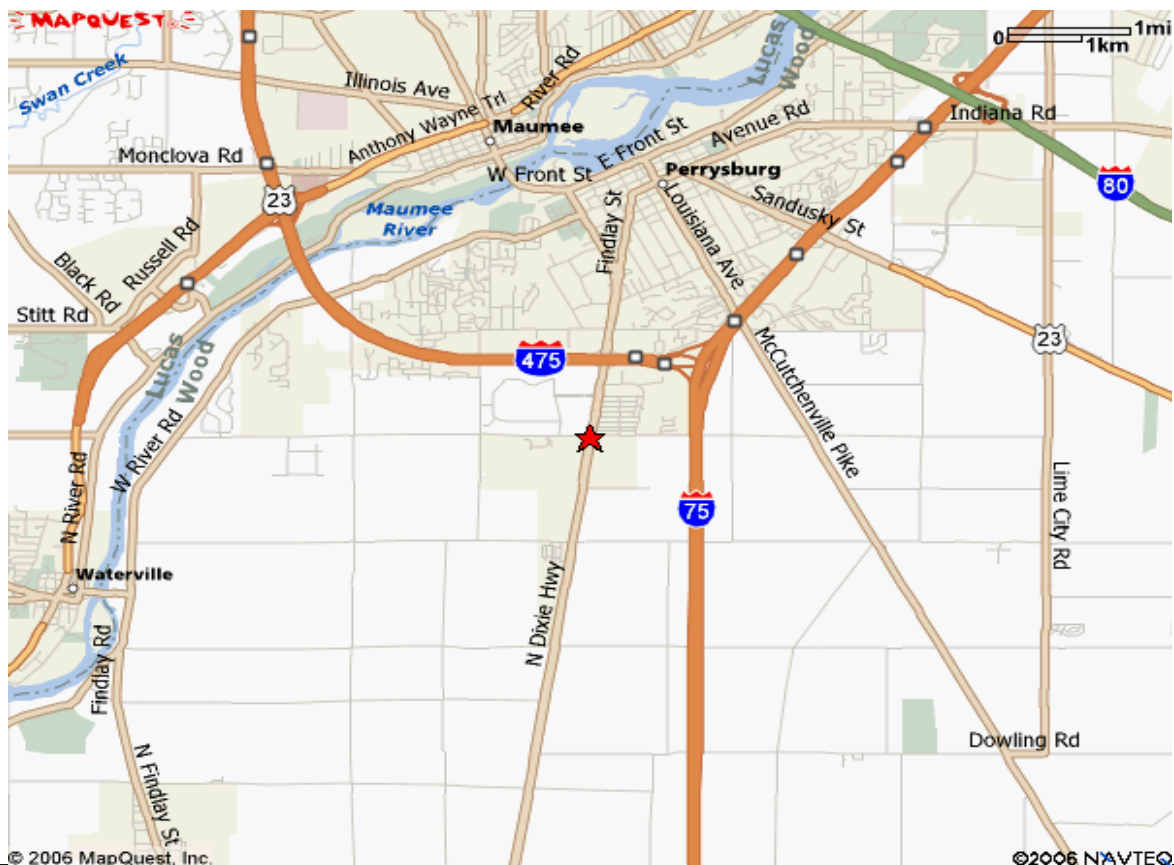
