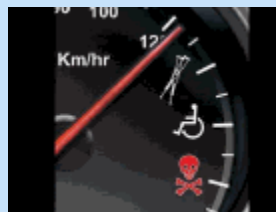
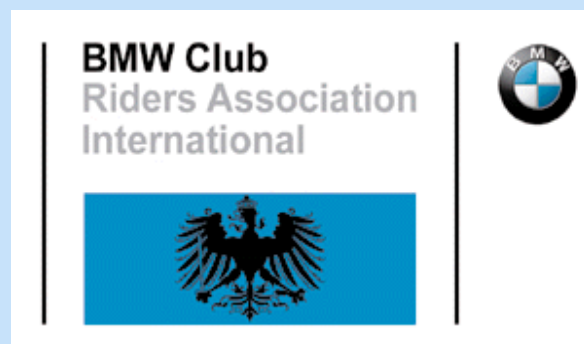

**Directions to Al & Cassies's** Turn right on Beaver Rd, and we are the driveway (on the right) just before the bridge/stream that passes under Beaver Rd. Significant landmarks for making sure you see Beaver Rd are: in order 1) Sippy Flats Carry-out and gas on the right; 2) Pickerel Lake Campground & M-37 Meat Shack on right; 3) Beaver Rd is about a quarter mile north of the Meat Shack on M-37 on the right. It will take about 4.5 hours from Toledo, depending on your speed and number of stops. It's around 275 miles through some nice riding country, but seriously, I have to warn you about the deer. We are right in the middle of the Manistee National Forest and our four-legged friends are everywhere, so I DO NOT recommend night riding. Please plan accordingly, as fatalities are a real bummer around the campfire.
