

Pinhole Projection: Light from the Sun enters the pinholes and gets projected out the other side, making an image of the Sun based on how far away from the surface it falls and how big the holes in the foil are.

Materials Needed:

- Aluminum foil
- Something to punch holes with
- A frame of some sort
- Clothespins to hold it in place


